Individual Education Programs are developed for each child. We provide a no nonsense, business-like approach to school. Many students graduate to our local high schools and enter the work world with continued success. I can create or coordinate a similar program for a school district or apply these skills and concepts in a regular school classroom.

1995-1998:

Coordinator/Teacher: Summit Program II – District #71, Cumberland Jr. Secondary School.

This was a self-contained program that focussed on rehabilitation for behaviour disordered youth. Instructional Education Programs were devised for each student (I.E.P.'s). Students were referred to our program: the goal was to provide full-time instruction to the students, until they were academically and emotionally ready to reintegrate into the school population. The following subjects were taught: English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Physical Education, Communications and Art. The program was highly successful and appreciated by the regular teaching staff. Teachers were able to identify potential candidates for the Summit Program and felt confident that a full-time behavioural specialist was meeting this child's academic and behavioural concerns.

1989-1995:

Special Education Coordinator/Head Teacher: Summit Program: School District # 61, Victoria

The Summit Program was designed for severe behaviour disordered youth requiring social, emotional and academic growth. This program was invaluably recognized at the District, The Ministry of Social Services and the Attorney General's offices. Our program's community work was often featured by the local media. The students participated in an Outdoor Education program which regularly presented physical, social and emotional challenges that affected tremendous development. Students were taught the four core subjects, Physical Education, Community Service and Outdoor Education.
